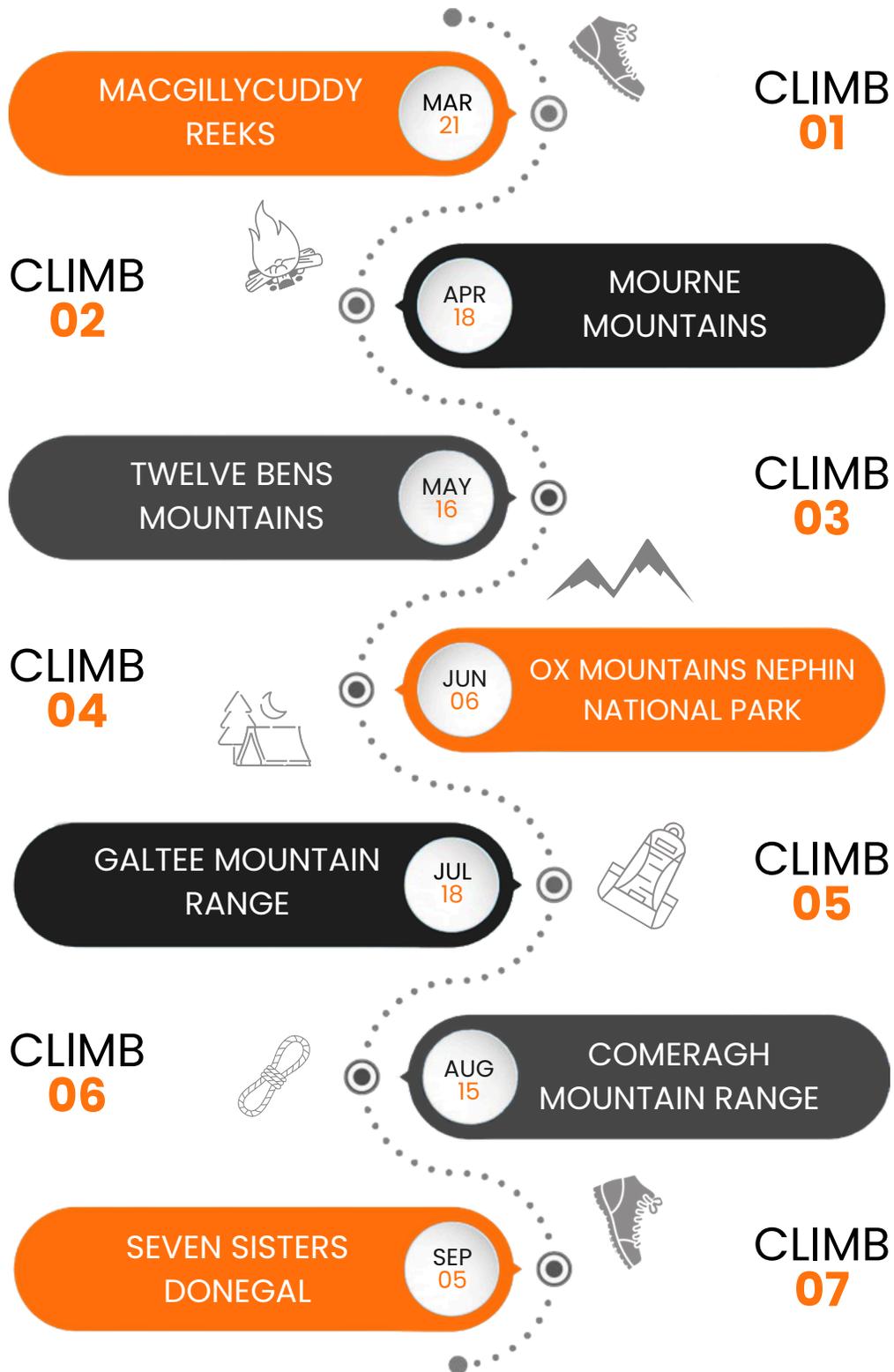

This mountain range, set on the Iveragh peninsula in County Kerry, is a long anticlinal range of glaciated Devonian sandstones, the reason for their many valleys, peaks, and ridges. This spectacular range of Irish mountains is also home to Carrantuohill, the highest mountain in Ireland standing at 3,414 feet.

The Mourne Mountains (Beanna Boirche), are situated in County Down in Northern Ireland. This compact range of granite peaks rises from the Irish Sea at Carlingford Lough. The historic town of Mourne separates the mountains, which date back to over 2.6 million years ago, from the sea.

The Twelve Bens is a rugged mountain range in Connemara, County Galway, Ireland, known for its dramatic peaks, with Benbaun being the highest. Rich in wildlife and cultural significance, the Twelve Bens are a key feature of Connemara National Park.

TRIP FACTS

OX MOUNTAINS NEPHIN NATIONAL PARK



This expansive mountain range stretches across Counties Sligo and Mayo along Ireland's western seaboard. Composed of ancient gneiss, schist, and granite formations, the Ox Mountains reach 544 metres at Knockalongy, while the nearby Nephin Beg range rises dramatically to form Wild Nephin National Park. Explore its dramatic valleys and pristine Atlantic blanket bogs, the Owenduff and Tarsaghaun river systems, and the remote wilderness surrounding Lough Easkey, Lough Achree, and the corrie lakes nestled high in the Nephin Beg Mountains.

Galtymore or Galteemore mountain, situated in the province of Munster is one of Ireland's highest peaks and is classified as a "major mountain." It is one of the 13 Irish Munros and is part of the Galtymore Mountain range made up of sandstone and shale, with 24 peaks above 100 meters.
